#### Parents

We have been offered swimming lessons for years Pre Primary and Year 3 during Term Two 2016. It is very important that children learn to swim confidently. These lessons have been highly subsidised by the Government and you are urged to make swimming lessons a priority for your child. The pool is heated and children change at the pool and do not return on the bus in wet bathers.

#### The cost per child will be \$45.00 which includes pool entry and transport.

The fees can be paid by cash, cheque or EFTPOS. Cash and cheques can be forwarded through the classroom teacher. Parents please make cheques payable to Burrendah Primary School. EFTPOS payments can be made in the front office during office hours.

The student enrolment and medical information must be completed. It is essential to have the correct medical information. If your child has any other special needs or requirements, these should be identified clearly to the school before the program commences.

Parents will be informed when your child's lesson time is finalised.

## **IMPORTANT – INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS**

- Students wear their bathers to the pool under their uniform.
- They require dry underwear to change into after their lesson.
- A plastic bag for wet bathers and towel after changing.
- Remember to dry your bathers and towel for the next day.
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- Swimming goggles are allowed.
- Lunch is at school.
- Slip on footwear may be worn to and from the pool.
