### SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2021

Each year parent/guardians support our school in many ways and contribute both financially and in kind. This support is crucial in ensuring quality programmes are available to our students and we thank those parent/guardians who provide that support year after year.

One very important part of that parent support is the payment of the annual "School Contributions and Charges".

**School Voluntary Contributions** – *in line with the School Education Regulations 2000 and endorsed by the Burrendah Primary School Board 2020.*

These amounts are set by the Burrendah School Board. For 2021 the amounts are:

Kindergarten	each child	\$60	(These amounts are at or below the maximum amount allowed through the Department of Education)
PP – Year 6	1 child	\$60	
	2 children or more	\$120	

Money collected will be used to supplement school funding provided by the government. While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning programs will be enhanced if each family makes a contribution.

More than ever in 2021 we need your support. We urge all parents to pay these contributions to assist us in maintaining the high standard of resourcing previously established. If all parents pay these voluntary contributions in a timely manner it will make a big difference to how we can resource our school in 2021. Through these contributions, the school will be able to supplement the purchase of equipment and materials that your children need for their classroom programs. These include reading and library books, maths resource equipment, sport and physical education equipment, technology consumables and art/craft materials. We look forward to your prompt payment of these voluntary contributions in 2021.

#### Items for Personal Use (Booklists)

The list of items for personal use will vary from student to student and includes:

- Pupil requirements for all students and used in lessons e.g. stationery items, calculator etc.
- Pupil requirements recommended but not essential for all students e.g. tissues, art shirt etc.

The recommended list of Items for Personal Use for your child has been previously distributed. All materials can be purchased through Ziggies Educational Supplies, 25b Baile Road, Canning Vale, however, you are not obliged to use this supplier.

#### School Charges

Charges are payments that parents are required to pay for their child to use such as Athletics, Readings Eggs and School Ipad Apps, and to participate in events such as excursions, swimming, sport carnivals, in-school events, special music etc. These charges are outlined on the back of this information sheet. For students starting Year 4, 2021 will see the introduction of BYOD (bring your own device – iPad), of which information has been disseminated to parents in Term 4 of 2020.

Charges listed are our 'best estimated' maximum projected costs you could expect to pay if your child took part in every listed programme during the year. These charges (aside from the iPad which is a family purchase) will be requested at an appropriate time during the year prior to your child taking part in each activity. Your timely payment when requested to pay these charges is needed to ensure your child is able to participate in events. *Please contact Manager Corporate Services if you need flexibility in making payments due to unforeseen circumstances or financial difficulty. We would be more than happy to assist you.*

#### Other Voluntary Approved Requests

The Burrendah Primary School P&C Association voluntary approved request from parents for 2021 will be \$25.00 per child as ratified by the P&C Association.
