

YEAR 6 CAMP 2022

Dear 2022 Year 6 Parents,

The camp at Point Water will go ahead. Due to COVID 19 policy from the Education Department, students who are close contacts may not attend camp. If a student develops Covid19 symptoms during camp they will require Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT). If they are not able to conduct the test themselves a staff member will conduct the test. Parents will be notified, and students will need to be collected if they have Covid or are unwell.

Due to camp difficulties to staff all our booked activities, there are a couple of changes. Paddling will be replaced by Ultimate Sports and High Ropes will be replaced by Crate Climb. This is disappointing but beyond our control.

Camp Details

Date: Monday, September 5th – Wednesday, September 7th, 2022

Itinerary:

Monday 5th February 2022

- Students arrive at school at 8:30am dressed ready to attend camp. They meet their class teachers in their own classroom with their luggage. After attendance checks, the buses will be loaded at 9:00am.
- Depart Burrendah at 9:30am travelling by Horizons West / Westwide Bus & Coach to Point Walter Recreation and Conference Centre, Stock Rd, Bicton.
- 10:00am - arrival and store luggage
- 10:00am - form into groups – one group will be walking to Goanna Golf at Point Walter Golf Course and the other group will stay at Point Walter camp site to complete two group activities including morning tea **(students need to bring their own morning tea and drink).**
- 11:15am - groups swap for Goanna Golf and Point Walter Camp site
- 12:15pm - return to camp
- 12:30pm - lunch
- 1:30pm - group team building activity
- 3:00pm - afternoon Tea
- 3:30pm - group team building activity
- 5:00pm - settle into dormitories (students need to make their own bed with 2 flat sheets, pillow slip, blankets and doona – this may need to be practised prior to camp), showers

Team Building Activities:

Goanna Golf, Point Walter Camp site activities – volleyball and orienteering, Ultimate Sports, Catapults, Flying Fox, Archery, Pool Games, Crate Climb, Kite Making, Team Building. Students will have the opportunity to participate in all eleven activities.

- Bed linen and bath towels are provided.
- Students may bring their own pillow even though one is provided.

Food:

All food is provided and prepared by Accolade Catering. Their meals are nutritionally balanced and conform to the School Canteen Traffic Light Criteria. We have catered for special dietary needs but if you have any concerns regarding meals please discuss it with the Camp Coordinator.

Please do not pack snacks and /or lollies as food is not allowed in the dormitories and the abundance of food ensures that no one will be hungry.

Camp Departure:

You need to pick up your child from Point Walter Camp and Recreation Centre, Stock Road, Bicton at 2:00pm Wednesday 7th September 2022. If you are not able to collect your child from Point Walter Camp and Reception Centre personally **you will need to arrange alternative transport and advise the onsite camp coordinator (Mr Brian Crouch) in writing**, the name and contact number of the person who will be responsible for collecting your child.

NO BUS WILL BE RETURNING TO BURRENDAH. (This is to reduce the cost of the camp.)
