### Music Concert & IMSS Soiree 2018

Dear Parents

We are having our annual Music Concert in Week 7 on **Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> of November at 6:00pm**. All students who are involved in the following groups are required to attend and perform at this event: Senior Choir, Junior Choir, String Orchestra, Wind Band, Chamber Strings Ensemble and Recorder Ensemble.

The IMSS Instrumental groups will be performing in a Musical Soiree on a separate night (please see over the page) as our Music program is now very extensive and far too much to fit into one night. Please read this entire note carefully.

The **Music Concert** will be held at **Burrendah Primary School**. This is our main music event and our music groups have worked hard all year. It is important for all music students to attend so that they do not let their team down.

- All students in the String Orchestra and Chamber Strings Ensemble are required to arrive by **5:30pm** in the **School Hall** to warm up and tune up
- All Students in the Wind Band are required to arrive by **5:30pm** in the **Music room** to warm up and tune up
- All Junior and Senior Choir students are required to arrive at school by **5:45pm** and need to sit in their reserved seating in the undercover area
- All students in the Recorder Ensemble are required to arrive at school by **5:45pm** in the **School Hall** to warm up and tune up
- It is recommended that students have a substantial dinner before arriving back at school
- All students need to bring a water bottle with their name clearly labelled on it
- Instrumental students need to come equipped with their **instrument**
- All students are to wear a clean, smart school uniform (blue school shirt) with navy bottoms and closed in shoes. Year 6 students are encouraged to wear their leavers' shirts

- All Students are required to arrive by **5:40pm** to warm up and tune up
- **Wind, Brass and Percussion** students to the **Music room**
- **String** students to the **School Hall**
- **Guitar** students to the **Art Room**
- It is recommended that students have a substantial dinner before arriving back at school.
- All students need to bring a water bottle with their name clearly labelled on it.
- Instrumental students need to come equipped with their **instrument and music**.
- All students can wear neat, smart casual clothes (not scruffy “play clothes”) and sensible shoes.
