

## **PBS Lessons Underway**

***Ask your child what behaviour expectation they learned in class***

The *Positive Behaviour Support (PBS)* curriculum for our **Responsibility Expectation** has begun in classrooms. The first **behaviour** taught was '**Own my Actions**', from the '**Everywhere, Every time**' row inside the **Behaviour Matrix**. Students watched videos of the Yes and No examples created by Teachers at our Pupil Free day on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July. All classrooms now receive one PBS lesson a week that links directly with the matrix. We look forward to seeing students using the language and displaying these behaviours.

## **What's in the Behaviour Matrix?**

The 4R's (Respect, Responsibility, Resilience and Reach) make up our **4 Expectations**. Under these 4R's inside the Matrix, are the **behaviours** we have chosen as a community. The locations where we expect to see these **behaviours** are Everywhere/Every time, Inside and Outside\*.

Each one of these **behaviours** forms a lesson, providing students, staff, and parents with a language and clear understanding of what each **behaviour** is for Burrendah Primary School.

\***Inside** is within a building such as a classroom, library, toilet block or wet area... **Outside** is outside a building such as the undercover area, oval, pathways, outside rooms, playgrounds...

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
