WORLD VISION FAMINE FUN EVENING

Dear Parents

In recent years our senior students in Year 5 & 6 have been given the opportunity to fundraise for World Vision. We have encouraged them to become more informed about the world hunger crisis and take some positive actions to address the situation.

Senior students can choose to participate in the Famine Fun Evening at Burrendah Primary School on Thursday 16th August from 3:00pm - 6:30pm. Students eat lunch at 11:45am and then they fast until approximately 8:00pm in the evening. Eight hours is the recommended time for children to fast. Students can drink water and we actively encourage them to drink regularly during the eight hour fast. Between 3:00pm and 6:30pm students participate in games and activities at school. The students gain sponsorship for their fast and there are two options for managing their sponsorship explained below. As a school we will participate in a range of awareness raising and fundraising activities, including our fundraising village market on Friday 17th August.

Students have two ways to manage their sponsorship:

- Sponsors can directly sponsor and donate using this page and monies collected can be added to this page.
- Alternatively, students can keep a record of their sponsors on a sponsorship form available on the school

 The sponsorship form needs to be returned to
 school with all monies collected by Friday 24th August.

This supports our work in encouraging our students to put our Nine Core Values into action and in particular, demonstrates 'compassion' in a practical way.

Please return the following slip, if you give your permission, for your child to attend the World Vision Famine Fun Evening on Thursday 16th August and to collect sponsors for their fast.

Permission notes need to be returned to school by **Friday 3rd August**. This is necessary in order to finalise the planning and staffing arrangements for the Famine Fun Evening, and to give students an opportunity to collect some sponsors for their famine.
