The Participant acknowledges: There is no qualified medical assistance available at "The Hangout" and that in the event of an injury requiring medical treatment; the Participant will need to obtain such assistance from an independent source.

I hereby release "V Rocks Pty Ltd", "The Hangout", all of its employees, staff and assistants or any other persons involved in my participation in indoor climbing at The Hangout from any suit, demand, action or claim for compensation, be it for personal injury or damage to property arising from my participation. I am aware that this waiver is ongoing and will apply to all future participation at The Hangout. I furthermore acknowledge that this document is contractual and may be relied upon in any proceedings by me, my heirs or executors.
